3. Organic tin compounds (Tributyl tin & Triphenyl tin)
4. Asbestos
5. Azo compounds
6. Lead & lead compounds
7. Hexavalent chromium compounds
8. Mercury & mercury compounds
9. Brominated organic compounds (Polybrominated biphenyls-PBB & diphenylethers-PBDE)
